Unfortunately, Hollywood is not producing the right kind of role models that parents want their kids to look up to. This is the age where influence and guidance is most important to keep our kids honest and on the right path to becoming their own unique self. Theatre is a great way to allow your kids freedom to express their creativity with other kids who share the same interest.

Riverdale Drama Club is offered to all grade levels and will meet Thursdays after school until 4:30. The cost will be \$10 per session since Riverdale will be bringing in a professional performer/director to teach the students. In order to make sure that the students receive the best possible experience, class space is limited to the first 25 to sign up before the first session on Thursday, September 4th. This club will only run during the First Semester as the play will take all of our time during Sem. II.

There will be 12 sessions during the first semester, so the total will be \$120 for semester. Families can also pay monthly, by the first Thursday of each month. Please make checks out to Riverdale. The school will make no profit from this activity. There will be 3 sessions in September, 4 sessions in October, 3 sessions in November and 2 sessions in December. It is important that you make sure to arrange that your children are picked up promptly at 4:30.
